

Greek Star Is
Confident Of
Easy Victory

WRESTLING reaches its pinnacle in Phoenix tonight when Jimmy Londos, internationally known Greek champion, meets Pete Sauer, former Phoenix boy, in the main event of the John C. Greenway American Legion post's mat program at their home in Phoenix Madison Square Garden.

The Sauer-Londos match will decide the new arena for wrestling and Matchmaker C. L. McPherson believes that from the flood reservations he will absolutely fill out the 3,000 seats in the new 1,000 arena.

At the final workout yesterday afternoon, the entire lower floor of the arena was packed with fans from all over the valley, and after the workouts, ticket offices down town were rushed for over an hour. The Londos-Sauer match is a thrill one for Phoenix fans here. Steve Sauer to be unbentable, long string of victories over some of the most noted matmen in the game has given him an unequalled place in the hearts of the fans. Jimmy Londos beat Sauer last year, the only defeat of the entire season for the former Phoenix boy.

Both Londos and Sauer were on hand for the final workout and in excellent condition.

Londos In Shape
Londos weighs 204 pounds and besides his workout yesterday afternoon, wound up his training with a mile walk yesterday morning. He is said to be the greatest defensive wrestler in the game. He won most of his matches by wearing down his opponent by a fast pace and then stamping a rally which a weakened opponent cannot mount. Londos is a master of the over-headlock and he originated the side-winder headlock that Pete Bauer now uses to perfection.

Sauer tips the scales at 183. He carries no fat and is far more aggressive in his tactics than Londos. While Londos wins by wearing his opponents out, in a fast match, Sauer usually wins by taking everything they have to offer and letting them beat themselves. It is said of Sauer that he can take more punishment than any other wrestler living, and came back strong.

At any rate, Phoenix will have the privilege of watching two of the greatest wrestlers of modern times in the ring tonight when Dr. P. L. Vissar, selected as referee, calls Londos and Sauer to the center of the rings for final instructions. Vissar is liberal in his ideas of wrestling. He does not object to rough tactics if both wrestlers want to play that kind of game. Moreover, Vissar is absolutely qualified to handle the two men tonight and has the fans with him.

Burger And Carter
The burger and Carter was a big attraction with local fans. Casey Burger will go to Boston, 13 to 11, here today, but held his 12-game lead as Brooklyn nixed out Pittsburgh, 2 to 1. Both teams employed three hurries.

Guy Bush was knocked out of the box in the second inning and Hal Carlson and Mike Evergreen followed. Gorham Leverett started for the Braves but a seven-run attack drove him from the mound in the sixth and Ed Brandt and Jim Conroy finished. Brandt getting credit for the victory.
